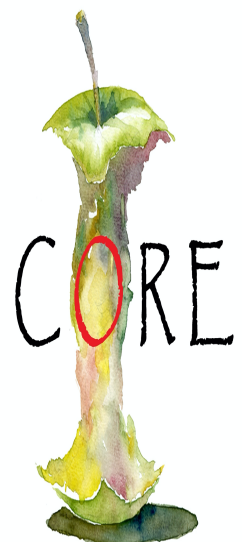
This session corresponds with the adult session ‘Integrity’



Have you ever had a response from your child that took you by surprise because it sounded like your voice coming from their tiny mouths? We have an uncanny ability to absorb the habits, self talk and philosophies of those we spend the most time with – for better or worse.

The story of the 3 slave boys who refused to bow in worship to an idol of the King (Daniel 3) give us a beautiful picture of what a life of integrity means.

Discuss as a family what choices you have made that please and honor God. Choosing integrity today probably won't lead to a furnace, it can still be hard to make the right choice. Share a story of when your integrity was tested with your family.



Take Action...

Spend time talking as a family about how each of you can stand up for God and what the cost of taking that stand could be. Pray together that each of you would be strengthened to walk with integrity and obedience to the Lord. Encourage each other in that decision.
